Lauren won the Stray FM bravery award last year for her work in schools sharing this message. Eight years ago she was hit by a van when she was out with friends which caused a spinal injury. Lauren is now paralyzed from the neck down. The children listened extremely respectfully and were able to ask Lauren questions about road safety, the accident and her disability. She is such an inspirational lady and the children all agreed that they would like to have more time to talk to Lauren and to ask her more questions. We will be inviting her back into school very soon.



Children from KS2 enjoyed helping the 'Open the Book' team tell the story of Joseph in collective worship.




Year 3/4 have been learning about Piet Mondrian in topic work this week. We found it tricky to not go outside the lines with our paintbrush.
